Minutes of September 5, 2017
Special Meeting

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on September 5, 2017 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Ralph Paull, Ruth Robinson and Robert Davis. Others in attendance; 2 members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar Robert Davis moved, Ralph Paull 2nd to approve the September 5, 2017 Agenda, the August 1, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes and the August 8 and August 15 Special Meeting Minutes and the August Invoices, MCU.

3.0 Public Input

Randy Hodel and Tony Cardoza, representing the Paisley Assembly of God Church, presented a Mosquito Festival donation to the City and expressed their appreciation for the Community outreach. There had been some miscommunication and a tent had been left up in front of the Community Center, for which they apologized. Melissa Walton stated there hadn't been a problem with it being there but had contacted someone when the wind had flipped it over so it didn't get destroyed. The Church expressed interest in helping with any Community Projects that come up.

4.0 Business

4.1 Damage to City Building, Repairs Ralph Paull moved, Ruth Robinson 2nd to accept the repair bid from Adam Albertson, MCU.

4.2 Surprise Valley Electric Proposal During discussion there were concerns raised and questions asked that Council would like the answers to before giving a final answer on the SVE Proposal. One large concern is the arsenic compliance. The Administrative Order issued to the City by Oregon Drinking Water stipulates the water system must be in compliance for 12 consecutive months during a set 18 month period. The City is concerned that making a big change to the water system may throw it off kilter thus violating the order. The City also worries about the sustainability of the water source and the legality of selling the amount requested by SVE. Council asked the Recorder to draft a letter to SVE expressing the concerns and asking Brad Kresge to attend the next Council meeting either in person or by phone to address questions.

4.3 Road Work Grant Council would like an itemized bid from Bobby Carlon concerning the work needing done.

4.4 **Speed Zone Request** Melissa Walton presented a flyer received from Elan City regarding a radar speed sign with cost. Budget wise nothing can be done at this time.

4.5 **Community Center Heating and /or AC Unit** Councilman Ralph Paull presented a quote he received from Seasons Change, LLC on replacing the heating unit within the Community Center. Prices given \$7,091 and \$10,858. Again budget wise nothing can be done at this time. The Recorder will look into available grants.

4.6 **Lake County Chamber of Commerce Membership** Ralph Paull moved, Robert Davis 2nd to approve paying the \$50.00 annual membership to the Lake County Chamber of Commerce.
