1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Special Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on August 15, 2017 at Paisley City Hall. 3.1 Surprise Valley Electric Proposal Mayor Blair stated to Council the City had not been able to speak directly to the Lake County Water Master. Joe Carlson, with Oregon Drinking Water Services, stated in an email that they (Drinking Water) have no jurisdiction over water the City sells. Mark Douglas stated that in talking with the Water Master and with Darwin Johnson, Lake County Planner, he had been told municipalities require an urban growth boundary and water couldn't be pumped out of those limits. In absence of an urban growth boundary City limits would be the line. Landowners outside of City limits can petition to be included. Mayor Blair feels the City needs more information to make an informed decision. Council Robert Davis reminded Council SVEC had stated they would help with repair work. Mayor Blair worries also about the infrastructure of the City's water source. **Robert Davis moved, Ralph Paull 2nd to table the discussion until further information has been received, MCU.**

3.2 Road Work Grant Mayor Blair read the bid received from Bobby Carlon. Mr. Carlon stated he can do the repairs for the amount of the grant as long as he can find a paving machine. He is hoping to get the work done this fall. Mr. Carlon will keep in touch with the City Recorder as to when he finds a paver to use.
