Minutes of November 3, 2015
Regular Meeting

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on November 3, 2015 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Dick Mecham, Robert Davis, Ronne Lindsay and Ralph Paull. Others in attendance; one member of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0 Agenda Approval

Ronne Lindsay asked to include 6.3 – TSP Update. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Ralph Paull 2nd to approve the Agenda with additions.**

3.0 Consent Calendar

3.1/3.2 Minutes for October 6, 2015 Regular Meeting and October Invoices. Ronne Lindsay moved and Ralph Paull 2nd to approve the Consent Calendar. MCU

4.0 Public Input

Ronne Lindsay reported to Council that a Community Member has complained about the condition of the road on Green Street and the Forest Service Road up Mill Street. Mayor Blair asked Ronne Lindsay if the repairs would fall under the TSP Plan or would the cost go to the County? Ronne Lindsay stated she doesn't believe there is a "road preservation" line in the TSP for Paisley. She would try to get an answer to that question and the question of whether the repairs have to be put up for bid.

5.0 Old Business

5.1 Paisley Mosquito Festival Update Melissa Walton reported to Council she that doesn't have an update at this time, she is meeting with an accountant, JeJei Estes, on Monday the 9th for some Quick Book clarifications. She will have an update next meeting.

6.0 New Business

6.1 PayPal Account Melissa Walton reported to Council that a Community Member from the Forest Service had approached her asking if the City would be interested in setting up a PayPal Account in order for them to pay for rental of the Community Center for their various meetings. She presented to Council a handout that a PayPal representative emailed her

stating there are no monthly or annual fees. They charge a transaction fee of 2.9% + \$.30 per use. Council Members asked if Customers would also be able to pay their bills online through this system, to which Melissa Walton stated she didn't see why not, but they would have to understand there would be a use fee for using this service, if implemented. For a \$25 payment there would be an additional \$1.02. Robert Davis suggested approaching US Bank and gathering information from them also to compare the two systems.

6.2 **CD Renewal, US Bank** Melissa Walton presented to Council a letter she'd received from US Bank concerning a CD that belongs to "City of Paisley, Water Sewer Maintenance Reserve". Mayor Blair states he believes this is a bond from when the City set up the sewer system. Mayor Blair stated to Council he thinks we should roll the CD over again but asks if Melissa Walton can find out for sure what it was and if there are restrictions. **Ronne Lindsay moved, Ralph Paull 2nd to renew the Certificate again for 6 months (standard), MCU.**

6.3 **TSP Update** Ronne Lindsay reported that she and Ralph Paull had attended the advisory meeting for TSP. During the meeting everyone had brought up many ideas and they had discussed what they felt was important, such as sidewalks around the Community Center and the gas station. Ronne Lindsay stated ODOT has dollars for smaller rural communities. They are encouraging these communities to come up with a "vision" for themselves, something that would encourage tourism. Other ideas include a flashing light coming down the hill that is on the north edge of town or a solar speed sign that says "Your speed is -----". Both ideas embrace safety issues. Ronne Lindsay said these wish list items need to be included in our plan or we will not have access to dollars. Ralph Paull asked if in putting in the sidewalks would homeowner's be responsible for upkeep? Ronne Lindsay states she doesn't believe so other than trees on homeowner's property which is causing damage to the sidewalk. Then she believes they would be responsible for repairs.

Ralph Paull reports to Council he spoke to Tony Cardoza and Angela Sanders concerning training for Vector Control. Tony stated he believes the School and the City split the cost, but Angela stated the City paid for John's training.
