Minutes of June 16, 2020
Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on June 16, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. People were also able to attend via teleconference at www.freeconferencecall.com. Call in number 701-802-5255, access code 332552. Or access via website, access ID “info34815”. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:34 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts and Robert Davis. Craig DeLarm and Krissy Funk (via teleconference). Others in attendance: Lora Mayae, Toni Bailie and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Dale Roberts moved, Robert Davis 2nd, to approve the June 16, 2020 Agenda and the June 2, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Ralph said Travis has found the parts for the hydrants are no longer available. Duane said there are extra parts around but Travis hasn’t found them. He does have a call out for quotes on replacements.
- 4.2 Fletch & Strings Archery, SD3A - Lease** Craig has agreed to the City receiving 10% of the profits if the Sporting Complex hosts a for-profit event and the profits are over \$1000.
- 4.3 Hazard Ordinance Amendment** Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to adopt the amended Hazard Ordinance #143 adding a \$50 per day fine to begin after a 30 day grace period to allow for compliance, MCU.
- 4.4 Paisley Disaster Unit Donation** PDU has donated \$3500 to the City for repairs to the Community Center.
- 4.5 FEMA Mitigation Plan** Paisley is under the jurisdiction of the County. This plan allows FEMA to help in case of a natural disaster. Robert Davis moved, Dale Roberts 2nd to adopt the FEMA Mitigation Plan for Lake County (Lake County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan), MCU.
- 4.6 Support for US Postal Service** Council discussed showing support of the Postal Service and the impact to small communities if they (we) lost that service. Craig DeLarm moved, Dale Roberts 2nd to approve a letter of support from the City for the US Postal Service, MCU.

- 4.7 **SCA Road Grant 2021 Application** After discussion of different streets and problems within city limits **Dale Roberts moved, Robert Davis 2nd to apply for the grant to repair Stratton Street and/or the end of West Street, MCU.**
- 4.8 **Enact Resolutions to receive State Revenue Sharing, Adopt Budget, Make Appropriations, Impose and Categorize Taxes for the 2020-2021 Budget** Dale Roberts moved, Robert Davis 2nd to enact Resolution No. 2020-03 061620 to adopt the budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 in the total amount of \$470,204.00 and to pass an Ordinance Declaring the City’s Election to Receive State Revenues for fiscal year 2020-2021. To make Appropriations for all funds in the amount of \$351,317.00 and total of reserve and unappropriated amounts, \$118,887.00 for a total adopted budget of \$470,204.00. To impose the ad valorem property taxes of all taxable property within the district for tax year 2020-2021 at the rate of \$1.5739 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for permanent rate tax. That the taxes imposed are hereby categorized for purposes of Article XI section 11b as: **Subject to the General Government Limitation - \$1.5739 / \$1000.00, MCU.**
- 4.9 **Mayor’s Review** Chuck Mobley is in town and is still willing to cut the trees and grind the stumps for \$2,000.00. He is having some truck issue so Ralph is not sure when he will be up and going again.

Carlton Court – the sign is now smaller and more expensive. Ralph is waiting on a quote. **Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to spend up to \$200.00 on the sign for Carlton Court, MCU.**

The alley is still blocked between Bob Daley’s, now Duane Graham’s, and Michael Cardoza’s. July 2nd makes it 30 days since the original letter was sent. Bob is going to talk to the State Fire Marshal about it as it creates a hazard and is blocking a City street.

Melissa talked to the County about a Free Dump Day. They cannot agree to a free day but may consider reducing fees. There is an organization willing to donate some money towards the fees. Council needs to organize it and present it to the County Commissioners.
