

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of October 7, 2014**  
**Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on October 7, 2014 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Mark Douglas called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Mark Douglas Jo Hoppe, Ronne Lindsay and Robert Davis. Others in attendance; Duane Young, Water / Wastewater / Street Superintendent, Mary Lou Sanchez, Bruce Gibbons, Ralph McAllister and Emma Villagrana, City Recorder.

**2.0 Agenda Approval**

**Jo Hoppe moved and Ronne Lindsay 2nd to approve the Agenda.**

**3.0 Consent Calendar**

**3.1/3.2 Minutes for September 2, 2014 Regular Meeting, September 12, 2014 Special Meeting and September Invoices. Robert Davis moved and Jo Hoppe 2nd to approve the Consent Calendar.** MCU

**4.0 Public Input**

Bruce Gibbons gave a verbal informational summary about U.S.F.S. meetings that he had been attending related to CFLR. He gave information about the program and amounts of money that is to be spent locally. He said that anyone who wanted further information could contact him and he would share what he knows.

Ralph McAllister asked the council to consider replacing or taking down the pole that the old fire whistle is attached to -located by the old City Jail. Mayor Douglas stated that this issue has been brought up before and needed to be considered.

**5.0 Old Business**

**5.1 Arsenic Treatment Update.** Mayor Douglas turned the update of the Arsenic Project over to Staff. Duane Young and Emma Villagrana updated the group on the progress made to date. Duane has installed the wastewater discharge line and done preliminary work for the water retention line. Mayor Douglas asked for a motion on the Arsenic contract. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Standard Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor for Construction Contract on the Basis of a Stipulated Price.** MCU

**5.2 Paisley Mosquito Festival Update.** Jo Hoppe informed the group that Mary Lou Sanchez has received a new shipment of I Love Paisley –

Mosquito Festival T-shirts and they will be for sale soon at the Homestead Restaurant

- 5.3 **Parking Ordinance.** The council had much discussion about the pros and cons of adopting a parking ordinance to address the issue of dead vehicles left on the city streets. It was general consensus to attempt to contact the dead vehicles owners and send them a letter requesting cooperation on this issue. If this does not work the council will look further into options for the vehicles removal. A draft letter will be composed and sent to council for approval.
- 5.4 **City Lot Fencing.** Duane Young asked the council what type of fence they wanted him to erect around the City lot by the old City Jail. It was brought up that the pole with the fire whistle on it should be addressed before a new fence is installed. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup> to take down the tower.** MCU Council discussed fencing options and decided that Duane should install t-posts with hog panels to fence in the lot.
- 5.5 **Community Center Repairs.** Mayor Douglas informed the group that the City had received the Economic Development money promised from the County. The Council reviewed the various estimates submitted and decided that the City will put out to bid for the refinishing of the Community Center Floors. A draft Request for Bid will be submitted to council for approval.
- 5.6 **PDU Lease.** After review and discussion, **Ronne Lindsay moved and Jo Hoppe 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve as presented the lease with PDU, with the change of name to Paisley Disaster Unit Board of Directors.** MCU

## 6.0 **New Business**

- 6.1 **Community Center Use Donation Refund Request.** A request had been made for a refund of a community center use donation. After much discussion, it was decided that the policy is that donations are non-refundable. This wording will be added to the Community Center Use Agreement.
- 6.2 **Lake County Library – Internet Share with City of Paisley.** A request had been received by the City to share an internet connection with the Lake County Library. The Library offered to pay all costs associated with installing a line for the two entities to share a connection and they would be willing to pay  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the City's monthly bill. **Robert Davis moved and Jo Hoppe 2<sup>nd</sup> to allow the Lake County Library to install and share an internet connection at no cost of installation to the City and for payment of  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the monthly bill.** MCU
