Minutes of May 5, 2020
Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on May 5, 2020 via teleconference at www.freeconferencecall.com. Call in number 701-802-5255, access code 332552. Or access via website, access ID “info34815”. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:22 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Craig DeLarm, Robert Davis and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Karon Paull, Lenora James, Bruce Gibbons, Toni Bailie and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd, to approve the May 5, 2020 Agenda, the April 21, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes and the April Invoices, MCU.
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is running fine. He noted there are two fire hydrants that need replacing. He will check for parts and add them to his budget request if needed.
- 4.2 Fletch & Strings Archery, SD3A - Lease** Working on the contract, table till next meeting.
- 4.3 Insurance Renewal** Melissa gave Council copies of the insurance renewal schedule. There were questions from the provider concerning older buildings and debris removal. Robert Davis moved, Dale Roberts 2nd to leave liability only on the old jail and remove the replacement value, MCU.
- 4.4 Resolution #2020-01 050620 A, Line Item Transfer, General Fund, Capital Outlay, \$4,500.00** Robert Davis moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to approve Resolution #2020-01 050620 A, transferring \$4,500.00 from line 30, Capital Outlay in the General Fund to line 32, Capital Outlay in the General Fund to purchase a fogger for the City’s vector control, MCU. Ralph would like to conduct a poll of community members asking if they want sprayed for mosquitos. If they care if the City uses city funds for spraying. And ask what ideas people have to fund the spraying. Melissa will put a notice in the water/sewer bills. Bruce takes his tests Tuesday morning. Bruce is willing to use the blue and white pickup for spraying. Council would like to get rid of the old spray truck and the malathion.
- 4.5 Resolution #2020-02 050620 B, Interfund Transfer, General Fund to Mosquito Festival Fund, \$1,672.00** Robert Davis moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd

to approve **Resolution #2020-02 050620 B, transferring \$1,672.00 from Materials and Services in the General Fund to Materials & Services in the Mosquito Festival Fund to purchase chemical for the mosquito spraying, MCU.**

- 4.6 Lenora James, Building Permit, Standing Water** Ms. James informed Council she is not going to submit her plans to build on her land. There is standing water in the field near the corner of the property. She had gone out last year and cleaned the mud out of the ditch. When she was there the other day and the water was backing up she went to look at it and feels that all she had dug out had been put back in. She is not able to continuously dig the ditch out. Her neighbor, Travis Way, and others explained its flood irrigation and has been happening for forty years plus. Ms. James is planning to send photos showing there wasn't any standing water last year. She does not plan to build at this time.
- 4.7 Mayor's Review Fees** – the Hazard Ordinance has no fees or fine attached to it and needs to be amended. After discussion **Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to amend Ordinance #143 to state after the 30 day period given for abatement or removal of hazard, the City will start charging \$50.00 per day in fees, MCU.** Community Center use fees are currently \$10 & \$25 for the small and large rooms respectively. It was suggested to raise a little or double the rate. No motion made. Office fees are currently \$0.25 for copies and Melissa is willing to notarize papers at \$3.00 a signature and pass the fees to the City. Council accepted.

Free Dump Day – Melissa hasn't heard from the County yet on this.

Lakeview Sanitation has been dumping in the lagoon for years. DEQ wasn't happy with how it was being done. Travis would like to try a different spot, maybe using a manhole out by the lagoon so that the refuse goes through the "chewer", but worries about it being overshot. He will work with them on this once some of the COVID issues are resolved. Ralph stated maybe the dumping isn't good for our system. Dale thought we had written them a letter stating dumping wasn't allowed anymore and that a padlock had been installed on the gate. Travis stated DEQ still hasn't finished the permit. He would like to wait on them to see if they are going to reclassify the City before moving forward with that and he has the padlock.

Spray truck and fogger – **Robert Davis moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to put the S10 and the old fogger out for bid including the disclaimer about the chemical, minimum \$200.00 on bid sheet, MCU.**

Opening City Hall – when able to reopen limit how far people can come into the office, either with the table or plexiglass. Opening the entire Community Center; Robert felt it was alright if people could social distance but worries about it being cleaned after usage. Craig, Ralph, Krissy and Dale are ready but feels we should wait for the go ahead. To be determined at the May 19th meeting.

Sheriff Taylor is working to get a police presence on at least Friday afternoons in town.

Called Jason Yeager on goat heads. Waiting on response.

Craig spoke with Carlons and has the wording for the plaque.
