Minutes of October 19, 2021
Regular Council Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on October 19, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Travis Way, Krissy Funk and Toni Bailie. Ruth Robinson out of town. Others in attendance: Joan Riha, Lavonna Temple, Norma Jean Carlon, Fara Brummer, Ila Jean Branum, Kenny Winebrenner and Melissa Walton, taking minutes.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the October 19, 2021 Agenda, and the October 5, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.
- 3.0 Business**
- 3.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is going smoothly. Toni asked about utilizing the well at the Catholic Church. Travis said a new well is part of the Water Master Plan from Anderson Engineering. Craig stated the County Commissioners have submitted the plan to the state. Craig had talked to Betty at SCOEDD about money for a back-up generator. Now that Betty is gone no-one is positive what source she was going to use for the funding; Denise is working on it.
- 3.2 Gary Clark, Property Acquisition** Tabled.
- 3.3 Varmint Control** John Sanders has asked Council if they want to use his services for varmint control. **Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve hiring John Sanders for varmint control at \$25.00 per animal beginning today. They ask that the animals be deposited a long ways from City limits. MCU.**
- 3.4 Community Center** Norma Jean Carlon would like to hold a Veterans Breakfast. It would be donations only, and open to the community, the money would be used to buy flags and wreaths for the cemetery. There were questions concerning renting the center and allowing use of the kitchen. Craig clarified the kitchen can be used but is not eligible for certification for Senior Meals. Melissa asked if Council would like her to contact the Ford Family Foundation on a grant for rejuvenating the kitchen and bringing it up to code so that it can be certified. **Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to apply for a grant from the Ford Family Foundation for revamping the kitchen, MCU.**
- 3.5 Krissy Funk, Building Permit; Garage** Tabled
- 3.6 Fara Brummer; Service Hookup** Fara and Colin Brummer purchased the small triangle of land directly across Mill Street from their driveway, next door to Michael and Kris Norris. They would like hook up to water and are considering eventually hooking up to sewer. Travis explained they can hook up to services with Council

approval, but the installation is at their cost. They will need to hire a licensed and bonded plumber, contractor.

3.7 PDU; Internet Set-Up The Disaster Unit would like to install a pole for internet services. They would like to set it up on City property just to the east and at the back of the building, on top of the hill. **Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve PDU setting up a pole on City property for their internet service, MCU.**

3.8 Mayor's Review Craig said that burning has been approved as long as its small and there has to be a hose on hand and a person has to be present. He also reminded everyone that the fire department can be approached about assisting but they are not required to be there to observe.

Dogs still running; need to send letters to owners.

People have been complaining about the deer but there isn't much of anything the City can do.

4.0 Reports / Correspondence Krissy reported that twice there has been a prowler(s) in her yard recently. She has to post no trespassing signs and her security system is in the process of being installed.
