**Regular Council Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on January 4, 2022 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:29 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Ruth Robinson, Krissy Funk, Travis Way and Toni Bailie. - 2.0 Executive Session** O.R.S. 192.660 (2) (i) Council moved into Executive Session for employee evaluations. Regular session resumed at 2:42 pm.
