

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of September 2, 2014**  
**Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on September 2, 2014 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Mark Douglas called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Mark Douglas, Dale Blair, Jo Hoppe, Ronne Lindsay and Robert Davis. Others in attendance; Duane Young, Water / Wastewater / Street Superintendent, Mary Lou Sanchez, Bruce Gibbons and Emma Villagrana, City Recorder.

Jo Hoppe asked if an ordinance pertaining to cars left on the roadway had been passed. It had not. Jo stated she was relaying inquiries from the public. Mayor Douglas stated that a nuisance ordinance is not good but that a “parking ordinance” would be appropriate. It had been looked into previously and Mayor Douglas had been in contact with Sheriff Phil McDonald who expressed his willingness to enforce such an ordinance. Bruce Gibbons asked if it would apply to County Roads-Mayor Douglas did not know off of the top of his head, but would research it. Mary Lou Sanchez asked if a vehicle was “tagged” if it would cost the owner money. The Mayor stated that it would be towed at the owner’s expense. Mayor Douglas will take action on researching this issue further

Jo Hoppe then asked if the Porta Pot is still on City Property behind the Pioneer Saloon. Duane Young stated that as of the last meter reading it was there. He had been told by the Pioneer Saloon Owner that it would be removed. Council was in general consensus to fence the property to help alleviate any further issues with the property. This topic will be put on next month’s agenda.

Ronne Lindsay reported that Lake County is paying for the new hand dryers for the public restrooms with STF funds. A Thank-you card from the City will be sent.

Mayor Douglas stated that since the City will be included in the planning on the County Grant it will help the City have better access to other grant funding opportunities.
