Minutes of November 3, 2020
Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on November 3, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:40 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Craig DeLarm, Robert Davis and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Toni Bailie and Travis Way. Melissa Walton, City Recorder was absent, meeting recorded.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Craig DeLarm moved, Dale Roberts 2nd, to approve the November 3, 2020 Agenda and the October 20, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU. October invoices tabled till next meeting.**
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis reported that Sunday the 1st he was notified of a water leak. They spent most of Sunday and Monday looking for valves to shut the water down in that area. Valves that are showing on the map aren't there and the ones they did find are old. He stated the City needs to make it a priority to look into grants for updating the system. Ralph asked about the overhead fill at the ranger station; it either needs to be disabled or they need to find another water source as it affects City water users when it is used. Travis is going to talk to the Forest Service about it.
- 4.2 Fundraiser** Tabled till spring.
- 4.3 Hazard Ordinance Complaint Update** The extension for the property on Mill expired on October 22. The owner has now begun to accrue fines. Travis is going to check the water meter ensuring it has not been turned back on. Council discussed finishing clean up and worries about confrontation if someone goes onto the property. There have been complaints of them driving up and down the street without headlights or taillights. The sheriff's office has been notified and community members will continue to call. **Krissy Funk moved, Dale Roberts 2nd, to put out a bid for salvage cleanup, MCU. Krissy Funk moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd, to move forward with theft of water complaint, MCU.**
- 4.4 Mayor's Review** Ralph wrote a thank you letter to all the fire fighters. He paid a \$66.00 fee to place it in the Examiner.

He thanked Amy Davis and her crew for the cleanup of the community center lawn before the Halloween Party.

The painting of the metal on the center has been moved to next spring/summer.

The speed zone survey for moving the speed limit to 25 has been suspended till 2021 due to COVID and fires.

He received an email and forwarded it to Council members concerning a movement to turnover rights from the state to towns themselves.

The community center is booked for a number of days in November. Ralph brought up and discussed with Council the risks and liabilities associated with renting the center out during the pandemic. The City cannot afford to be fined because someone is not following the state’s mandates, nor can they afford to be sued because of illness or death. Melissa will contact the City’s lawyer to find who is legally responsible and if necessary, the user agreement will be revised.

Council would like Melissa to include a statement in water bill reminding people to take proper cold weather preparation for their water and sewer pipes.

- 5.0 **Reports / Correspondence** Dale Roberts is resigning his seat. He is moving out of the area. Melissa will post the open seat.
