

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of November 17, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on November 17, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Craig DeLarm and Robert Davis. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Collette Broadfoot and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Craig DeLarm moved, Robert Davis 2nd, to approve the November 17, 2020 Agenda, the November 3, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes and the October Invoices, MCU.**
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis reports everything is running normally.
- 4.2 Vacant Council Seat** Tabled till next meeting.
- 4.3 Paisley Disaster Unit, Grant** Jon Jones with the Disaster Unit, approached Council concerning funds from the Cares Act. He would like to be able to acquire power lift equipment for the ambulance. They have a small number of volunteers and would be unable to lift someone into the ambulance without assistance. The lift he's looked into is rated at a 700 pound capacity, in testing it failed at 3600 pounds. He has also approached the hospital and the county with this same request. If able to secure funding from all three they may be able to install lifts in both ambulances. This would become necessary if the pandemic reaches our area as predicted. Melissa stated the City can use a small amount of the funds for masks, gloves, and sanitizer. **Craig DeLarm moves, Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup>, to apply for the funding for the lift and the City needs, MCU.** Jon Jones thanked Council and agrees to keep them updated.
- 4.4 Amy Davis, Winter Carnival** Melissa stated the Festival Committee and the VIPs would like to hold an outdoor winter carnival and include a couple of local vendors on December 6. Council agrees to approve the outside event as long as it fits the state mandates. A solid decision cannot be made until we know what those mandates are.
- 4.5 Supplemental Budget** Melissa reported we are going to have to go through the supplemental budget process she will have more information next meeting. There is a grant for the water master plan that was not included in the budget and there are some other income and expenses that need accounting for.

**4.6** Mayor's Review Ralph would like to have Council pursue the deer issue/ordinance. There have been numerous complaints on the amount of deer and the aggression people are witnessing. Ralph and a couple other community members are going to do "deer surveys" throughout town for the next couple of weeks. They will mark dates, count numbers and give locations of the groups so there is a good estimate of the deer population. Can move forward with the ordinance/state proposal after that. There are a few things that need looking into; processing fees, harvesting locations, waivers of responsibilities, these have to be included in proposal to the state.

Robert asked if the water meter had been checked on the property up Mill St. Travis has checked it and no usage. On the 16<sup>th</sup> Ralph hand delivered to the owner the last letter written by the City discussing fines and cleanup. The salvage cleanup person needs to be posted in the newspaper.

**5.0** Reports / Correspondence Melissa reported on the phone meeting with Home Serve USA concerning the homeowner insurance policy being offered. They would like a customer list or they are willing to buy it from an outside source. **Craig DeLarm moved, Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup>, to have Home Serve buy the list from another source rather than the City pass them customer information, MCU.**
