Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on July 7, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. People were also able to attend via teleconference at www.freeconferencecall.com. Call in number 701-802-5255, access code 332552. Or access via website, access ID “info34815”. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:32 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Craig DeLarm , Robert Davis and Krissy Funk (via teleconference). Others in attendance: Toni Bailie, Travis Way, Collette Broadfoot, Ila Jean Branum and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Craig DeLarm moved, Dale Roberts 2nd, to approve the July 7, 2020 Agenda, the June 16 Budget Hearing Minutes, the June 16, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes and the June Invoices, MCU.**
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Used the mower deck, it works great, definitely worth the investment. He is working to order replacement parts for the hydrants, new runs \$1500-\$1800 each. There was an article in the Community Breeze concerning a leak a Paisley resident had. There were inconsistencies in the article that he would like to see a retraction of. **Council voted unanimously to ask the Breeze for a retraction or correction to the article.**
- 4.2 Gregory Nichols, UAD Factory; Introduction, use of Airport** Greg Nichols and Steve Wilson, both from UAD out of Bend, introduced themselves and explained their company’s business. They will be holding trainings for running an unmanned aircraft system from the airport. They plan to practice flying northeast of the strip over the desert. Their classes will consist of roughly 20 military personnel. Each practice session will have numerous people present so there is always visual observance of the craft. They ask if there are any concerns or questions to please contact them they would be happy to discuss the procedures.
- 4.3 Dump Day Update** A group is planning to donate \$150 to ICFC so that the residents of Paisley can have a “free dump day”. There will be stipulations to the amount per household, the area for who is able to participate, no hazardous materials; batteries, chemicals, paint. A council person or employee of the City needs to be on hand during the event and it has to be approved by the County Commissioners. **Craig DeLarm moved, Krissy Fund 2nd to hold the “Free Dump Day” on August 8, 2020, MCU.**

- 4.4 **Audit Bids** Two bids were received; Price, Fronk & Co. from Bend, \$7,500.00 and Umpqua Valley Financial from Roseburg, \$6,700.00. **Craig DeLarm moved, Robert Davis 2nd to accept the \$6,700.00 bid from Umpqua Valley Financial, MCU.**
- 4.5 **Hazard Complaints** There were copies given of two complaints within the City. Council will read and discuss next meeting.
- 4.6 **Mavor's Review** Ralph presented a petition and a letter for the County Commissioners concerning policing within Paisley. He would like to pass these to the community and send them with the letter. **Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to send the petition with the letter to the County Commissioners, MCU.**

The sign for the basketball court was presented to Council. A thank you needs to be sent.

Need some mosquito traps. They let you know if spray is effective. \$10-\$15 each. There was a request for spraying out of City limits. The license is for public property, the sprayer and chemical would have to be driven to property and then the owner would have to spray the property themselves. Council would like to support the community but worries this would bring some issues. Checking into whether a district is necessary or viable. Table till next meeting.

The alleys within the City belong to the City and the residents are required to remove their possessions. Council is going to try talking to them again before involving the Sheriff's Office.

The GMC Astro Line truck is to be put out for bid; minimum \$2,500.00.
