

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of July 21, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0** **Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on July 21, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. Or access via website, access ID “info34815”. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:36 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Robert Davis and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Collette Broadfoot, Bruce Gibbons, Ralph McAllister and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0** **Executive Session** None
- 3.0** **Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Krissy Funk moved, Dale Roberts 2nd, to approve the July 21, 2020 Agenda and the July 7, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.**

- 4.1** **Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is running well.
- 4.2** **Dump Day Update** Melissa talked with Buddy Kness about the “Free Dump Day” for Paisley. He recommends speaking to the County Commissioners before setting a date. She is scheduled for the morning of August 4, 2020. Council will set a date afterwards. The flyer needs to be updated to include no hazardous materials are to be included; batteries, paint, etc. Also to include one truck load up to bed rails and for residents within a five mile radius of Paisley.
- 4.3** **Hazard Complaints** Three complaints were passed out to Council. **Krissy Funk moved, Robert Davis 2<sup>nd</sup>, to begin the process by sending letters stating the land owners and/or occupants have 30 days for compliance before beginning to accrue \$50.00 per day fees, MCU.**
- 4.4** **Vector Control** Dale contacted the state asking about spraying out of City limits. They have replied no, the license only allows the operator to spray property belonging to the City. There was discussion of the feasibility of forming a district. To be revisited next meeting.
- 4.5** **Mayor’s Review** Painting on the outer walls will begin soon. The metal on the eaves were not included in the bid. There was discussion on painting the metal versus replacing with a colored metal. Krissy is going to get prices on replacing the metal and Council will discuss next meeting.

The letters for the County Commissioners – there are some community members that worry the letter may make the Sheriff mad and then the City won’t get any

help. But Ralph stated, after the community members have already signed the petitions it wouldn't be proper to not send it in. Council hopes to have a phone conversation with the Commissioners and the Sheriff during the next meeting. There was discussion of putting out portable speed bumps but were informed that there is a safety and liability issue if they are put on the roadway. A flashing speed sign is about \$7,000.00. If one was placed with a camera on Mill Street or Hwy 31 can the City pull the revenue themselves?

There are a bunch of screws sticking out of the tin on the roof of the Community Center.

We have lost the custodian for the Community Center. Bids have been posted for someone new, deadline August 4, 2020.

There was an article in the Herald & News concerning possible prison closures in Coos Bay and Lakeview. Council agrees to write a letter to the state stating the detriments of closing Warner Creek.
