**Minutes of July 1, 2014**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on July 1, 2014 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Mark Douglas called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Mark Douglas, Robert Davis, Jo Hoppe and Ronne Lindsay. Others in attendance; Duane Young, Water / Wastewater Superintendent, Mary Lou Sanchez, Jon Jones and Emma Villagrana, City Recorder.

**5.0 Old Business**

5.1 **Arsenic Treatment Update.** Mayor Douglas turned the meeting over to Duane Young and Emma Villagrana for an update. Emma asked that the council review the email that was printed out from Anders Rasmussen. She stated that the new bid packet was just being printed. Mayor Douglas recommended that an electronic version be forwarded to Council Members for review as it is over 300 pages. Council agreed. Emma will forward the email packet to the Council and Duane who will review the packet and give his approval or request changes as necessary. After Duane's approval, Council will hold a vote to approve the packet as presented or request changes so that it can be put out for Bid.

5.2 **Paisley Mosquito Festival Update.** Jo Hoppe presented the Council with a letter that she is going to send to potential Donors for this year's Festival. She handed out the Flyers for the Car Show, Rodeo and Mosquito Festival Schedule. The council then discussed the most equitable way to address requests to spray for mosquitos outside of City limits. After deliberation, **Ronne Lindsay moved that Mosquito Abatement Service Outside of Paisley City Limits within a 7 mile**

radius, \$24.00 per site / per application will be charged. Jo Hoppe 2<sup>nd</sup> MCU.

- 5.3 **EMT Representative Jon Jones – Request for property consideration**  
Jon Jones addressed the Council about his search for a location for a new Ambulance Shed. He stated that the previous two locations being considered were not viable options after further investigation and the letter of opinion received from the City’s Attorney. His new idea is to improve upon the existing shed by extending it and additional 40’ and adding insulation. He said the EMT’s will still build a shed for the City to store its Mosquito Spraying Chemicals. General Consensus from the Council was that this was the best idea yet. Mr. Jones stated that the Young brothers should also get credit for this idea.
- 5.4 **Review Submitted Bids for Review Services for 2013-2014 Fiscal Year.** Two Groups submitted bids for Review Services -a one year term commencing with the 2013-2014 Fiscal Year. The contract has on optional renewal clause for the following two years. Bids were as follows: Rusth Spires and Assoc., LLP for a three year cost of \$17,100.00 and Oster Professional Group, CPA’s, LLP with a three year cost of \$10,659.00. After council discussion, **Ronne Lindsay moved to accept Oster Professional Group, CPA’s, LLP bid for service. Jo Hoppe 2<sup>nd</sup>. MCU**
