

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of August 17, 2021**  
**Regular Council Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on August 17, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Toni Bailie, Ruth Robinson and Travis Way; Krissy Funk absent. Others in attendance: Gary Clark with Toni Bailie taking minutes for the City Recorder.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Council approved the August 17, 2021 Agenda and the August 3, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes.
- 3.0 Business**
- 3.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis said there are no problems to report, most residents are abiding by the restrictions on outdoor watering.
- 3.2 Homelessness** Krissy Funk was absent, no report; tabled until next meeting.
- 3.3 Mosquito Festival Update** No report available; tabled.
- 3.4 Gary Clark, Property Acquisition** Craig reported he had acquired records from the court house showing that Hope Chapman owned the property but fell behind on taxes. The Methodist Church bought the property to help her out. The Church then sold the property to the City in October of 1976. Assessed value of the property will be determined and a decision made at the next meeting.
- 3.5 Animals Within City Limits** Neighbors have complained about the number of cows in a small pasture located within City limits. The cows are owned by Boss Murphy. They are currently in a pasture owned by Duane Graham. Craig will contact Duane and inform him the animals are in violation of City Ordinance. There have also been reports of stray dogs running loose at night, attacking fawns. No action recommended at this time.
- 3.6 Paisley Perk Lease** Lori Lorenz at the Paisley Perk has said she thinks it is fair to increase the rent she pays from \$50 to \$75 or \$100 per month, beginning in 2021. A motion was passed to increase the rent per Lori's request.
- 3.7 Renting Storage Space** A fiber optic company has requested a space to store cable reels, beginning in November. They want to rent an acre to an acre and a half of the 17.4 acres owned by the City near the rodeo arena. Motion was passed to approve the request, with rent to be determined when the contract is drafted.
- 3.8 County Roads in City Limits** Craig will ask the County Commissioners to order maintenance of the County-owned streets within the City; Mill Street, Green Street and

Blue Street. Craig also needs permission to change out two stops signs on those county streets.

**3.9 Kristine Funk, Electrical Permit** Kristine Funk’s request for an electrical permit was tabled until Council receives her plans, then they will consult with Darwin Johnson on planning rules.
