Minutes of December 7, 2021
Regular Council Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on December 7, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:25 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Krissy Funk and Toni Bailie. Ruth Robinson and Travis Way were unable to attend. Others in attendance: Jeremy Funk, Shelby Northwick, Andrew Funk, and Melissa Walton, taking minutes.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to approve the December 7, 2021 Agenda and the November 16, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes, and the November Invoices, MCU.
- 3.0 Business**
- 3.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Absent.
- 3.2 Permits, Variances**
- **Funk; building permit** Tabled due to not enough Councilors present to vote.
 - **Hyde; variance permit** Application to be returned, needing more information.
- 3.3 Nuisance Issues** The letters for the “at large” dog owners have been sent out. Council discussed using the new Code Enforcement Officer for Lake County. The new officer is pretty backed up, not sure when we would be able to utilize them. The property on John Street still has an abundance of animals. The property on Main Street is being cleaned up.
- 3.4 Community Center** Tabled.
- 3.5 Water Assistance Program** Melissa was contacted by KLCAS concerning a program for helping people with their water bills. They are just in the beginning phase of setting up the program.
- 3.6 Potholes** Joan Riha talked to Melissa about more potholes around town. There are three on the hill on Main Street and a large one on Marshview. Information will be relayed to Travis.
- 3.7 ARPA Funds**
- **Backup Generator** The funding from SCOEDD did not come through. Craig spoke to an employee who has since retired, about the funding for the generator; they had said there was money available and on its way. The new administration is not sure where she was planning to get the money from and no one has received any funds. They believe there was a misunderstanding and the previous employee was discussing ARPA Funds from the Federal Government. Council discussed the possibility of spending a large sum of

money on a new generator but having to wait 9 to 12 months to receive it or buying a used generator which doesn't carry a warranty. Toni and Krissy would like to order the generator and get it coming. Craig asks for a little more time to do some shopping. He also reminded them that a large chunk of the money will have to be spent on a certified electrician to come to Paisley and hook the generator up. Krissy asked if the City could address water conservation earlier this upcoming year and asked what the plans were with the Cemetery. Craig is going to make contact with them.

- 3.8 Mayor's Review** Craig stated there was an incident this past weekend that upset the community. There was an individual speeding up and down Mill Street, spinning broodies on others property, observed exchanging something with four other individuals in town, they eventually dumped their car in a ditch up Mill Street. The sheriff's office was called, but by the time they arrived the individual could not be found. The car was reportedly impounded. If anyone in the community sees something that needs to be addressed by police enforcement, do not call dispatch, dial 911.

It was asked if Council could address the issues with conditions and inhabitants of the trailer park. General consensus was no.

- 4.0 Reports / Correspondence** Krissy asked if a flier for HomeServe could be posted.
- 5.0 Public Appearances** Jeremy Funk asked about the skunk issues in town. Craig told him there is a gentleman in town that is trapping them. Jeremy also asked if the company the City bought the generator from could provide an engineer for installation.

- 7.0 Adjournment** Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to adjourn the meeting at 2:38 pm.
