Minutes of December 21, 2021
Regular Council Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on December 21, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. President Ruth Robinson called the meeting to order at 5:02 pm. Council Members in attendance were Ruth Robinson, Krissy Funk, Travis Way and Toni Bailie. Craig DeLarm was traveling. Others in attendance: Melissa Walton, taking minutes.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to approve the December 21, 2021 Agenda and the December 7, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.
- 3.0 Business**
- 3.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis discussed the need for a back-up generator for the water system. He stated we should have a local electrician come out and give us a quote on installing a generator. Then move on ordering a generator for the system. Council discussed buying used versus new. A used generator will not come with a warranty and Council agree that is not a wise decision. He also asked Melissa to make contact with Anderson Engineering to find out where we are at with any grants. Toni asked Travis about utilizing the well by the Catholic church; Travis stated it needs to be looked at, he believes it's a smaller domestic well that may not be viable for City usage. Melissa asked Travis to mention parts needed for the hand dryers in the outside bathrooms when he talked to the electrician. Council asked her to look at the prices of replacing the dryers versus paying for parts and installation.
- 3.2 Potholes** Community member Joan Riha asked Krissy Funk to bring up the potholes on the hill and on Marshview during the meeting. Travis said he is aware of them but until spring there really isn't much that can be done. He's tried filling them with gravel before and the repair doesn't last any length of time.
- 3.3 Permits, Variances**
- **Funk; Structural Permit, Carport** Toni Bailie moved, Travis Way 2nd, to approve the structural permit for the carport on the Funk property, MCU.
 - **Funk; Building Permit, Garage** Toni Bailie moved, Travis Way 2nd, to approve the building permit for the garage that will be placed on the existing cement pad on the Funk property, MCU.
- 3.4 Nuisance Issues** Krissy received a message from one of the recipient of the "dog at large" letters expressing concern for their animal. They asked if the City could address the issue with her neighbor as he is the one that keeps letting her dog loose. Council recommends that she contact the sheriff's office and files a trespassing complaint.

Melissa did have one other person come into City Hall to discuss the letter they had received.

- 3.5 Community Center** There have been questions and concerns over the condition of the flooring in the center. Ruth stated the school does have someone coming into the gym to work on the floor this spring. The City may be able to have them come in and work on this floor. Melissa will start gathering information for the process. Another issue raised was painting the inside of the center. The bathrooms and entry way inside the building are pretty rough. **Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to get quotes on having the inside of the Community Center painted, MCU.**

Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to waive the usage fee of \$50 for the Paisley Disaster Unit for their December 15th meeting, MCU.

- 3.6 Mayor's Review** None

- 4.0 Reports / Correspondence** Bruce Gibbons needs to renew his license by December 31 or he will have to retake the test for vector control. Council would like to see the spraying records and records of training. After discussion they agree that each employee and contractor should be evaluated annually along with having contracts and job descriptions reviewed. Council will go into executive session next meeting, January 4th, to meet with and evaluate each person. Melissa will relay this meeting information to them; Council asked Bruce to renew his license and submit the receipt for reimbursement after the meeting.

Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to discontinue the quarterly night meetings as nobody shows up for them and the afternoon meetings are much more convenient for Council Members, MCU.

Ruth asked that everyone watch for teenagers misbehaving around town. If they are drinking, etc. to call 911 and report them. She reminded everyone that the dorm kids are also not allowed to be riding in any vehicles with a student driver.
