Minutes of April 6, 2021
Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on April 6, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. President Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:30 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Ruth Robinson, Toni Bailie and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Joan Riha, Lora Mayea and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Resignation and Appointing a New Council Member** A copy of the resignation letter from Ralph Paull was given to each Council Member and read out loud to the assembly. **Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to accept Ralph’s resignation with regrets, MCU. Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to appoint Travis Way to fill the open seat on Council, MCU. Melissa stated to Council there were two people interested in filling the Mayor position, Ruth Robinson and Craig DeLarm. A vote was called; Toni Bailie voted for Craig DeLarm, Krissy Funk voted for Craig DeLarm, Travis Way abstained from voting. Motion passes to appoint Craig DeLarm as Mayor. Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to appoint Ruth Robinson as Council President, Travis Way abstained from voting, MC.**
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the April 6, 2021 Agenda, the March 16, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes and the March Invoices, MCU.
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis suggested posting ways of conserving water. We aren’t ready to start watering days and times but it may need to be done soon. Someone from Council plans to attend the Cemetery Board meeting.
- 4.2 Mosquito Festival 2021** Krissy will talk to Amy Davis and the Mosquito Festival Committee.
- 4.3 Airbnb/Camping/RV/Tiny Homes – Conditional Use/Variance** Rules and regulations need to be gathered from the County and LOC. Discussion tabled for the moment.
- 4.4 CASA Yard Support Signs** Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve placing the support signs and windmills from CASA in the yard at the community center, MCU.
- 4.5 Asset & Depreciation Threshold** Krissy Funk moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve setting a threshold of \$5,000.00 for the asset/depreciation schedule after the auditor recommended doing so, MCU.

- 4.6 **Mosquito Spraying** Ruth Robinson moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to have Bruce Gibbons start spraying for mosquitos and to post a “no spray” sign up sheet at the post office, MCU.
- 4.7 **Meeting Times** Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to keep the regular meeting time at 1:30 pm and to have an evening meeting once a quarter. The next evening meeting will be June 15th at 5:00 pm, MCU. Reminders will be included in water/sewer bills and be posted at the post office and store.
- 4.8 **Mayor’s Review** Craig plans to meet with Sheriff Taylor on Tuesday to discuss patrolling in Paisley. Visits from OSP and Sheriff Deputies have already increased.

Forming a “City Use Committee” to review fees, permits, funding opportunities, etc. is under consideration. This committee will not make any decisions or form any rules; they will just review and bring their findings to City Council during regular meetings.

Burn permits will be required as soon as the fire risk reaches high.
