Regular Meeting

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on December 1, 2015 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Dick Mecham, Robert Davis and Ralph Paull. Others in attendance; one member of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0 Agenda Approval

Melissa Walton reported she had been contacted by a community member asking who was going to decorate the tree out front. Council believes Hoppe's took care of it last year. Ralph Paull volunteered to coordinate the proceedings.

5.0 Old Business

- 5.1 CD, US Bank** – Melissa Walton reported to Council she had called Theresa Vickerman and US Bank concerning the CD. Theresa Vickerman said the CD was started a long time ago and throughout the years, when there was excess funds, they would be deposited into it. She believes it originated from when the water/sewer system was put in. US Bank stated there is another CD that will reach maturity in December. This one is from the General Fund. Mayor Blair and Council agree to leaving the CD untouched at this time.

6.0 New Business

- 6.1 Ginger Casto, SCOEDD** – Ginger Casto presented information to the Council explaining what SCOEDD is and how they are able to assist the smaller communities in receiving federal and state dollars to help with community development projects. Her main goal is getting the word out letting people know what's available. Ms. Casto is willing to meet with any group that is interested in initiating community development.

6.2 PayPal/US Bank Services – Melissa Walton presented to Council the information she had accumulated from PayPal and from US Bank concerning an alternative method of receiving payment for either use of the community center or payment for water and sewer bills. After discussion Council agrees that the cost of either service would far exceed its usage. **Robert Davis moved and Ralph Paull 2nd to not go forward with either method. MCU**

6.3 ODOT 2016 Special City Allotment Program – Included in Council’s packet was a letter from Oregon’s Department of Transportation stating the proposed project (West St. and Willow St. Project) was approved for inclusion in the 2016 grant program. The letter states there will be an Intergovernmental Agreement document coming through email that needs to be signed and executed.

Melissa Walton stated to Council Diane Elder had called her and asked for a refund of a check she written for use of the Community Center on October 16, 2015. Mrs. Elder had attended a Cemetery District meeting and had paid the use fee as they left.
