

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of October 6, 2015**  
**Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on October 6, 2015 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Dick Mecham, and Ronne Lindsay. Others in attendance; three members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

**2.0 Agenda Approval**

Ronne Lindsay asked to include 8.1 – TSP Update. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Dick Mecham 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Agenda with additions.** MCU

**3.0 Consent Calendar**

**3.1/3.2 Minutes for August 4, 2015 Regular Meeting and September 24 Special Meeting also August and September Invoices. Dick Mecham moved and Ronne Lindsay 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Consent Calendar.** MCU

**4.0 Public Input**

Melissa Walton reported to Council that she's had a few community members approach her concerning a dog issue and the ongoing issue of a property on Mill Street where it's been reported someone's living in a RV. She stated she's sent the questions onto the City Lawyer and his response was to send another letter, regular mail, which she has done. He's also told her as for "putting raw sewage on the property, then I think it can be reported to DEQ for investigation. Ultimately we can consider a civil suit against him." "Finally, his neighbors have the right to bring a nuisance action against him on their own." Melissa stated that every letter she has sent she has copied and sent to DEQ also. As for the dog, a community member was out running and the dog acted like it was going to attack. A neighbor was pulling out of the driveway and distracted the dog so she could get away. Melissa has told her to contact the sheriff and report it. Council agrees. After discussion Council asked Melissa to send registered letters to all owners of the property in question, letting them all know the issue will be sent on to DEQ for investigation if not resolved soon.

**5.0 New Business**

**5.1 Appointing new council member** Mayor Blair thanked Mary Lou Sanchez for her interest in the open seat on City Council. He wanted to let her know by the time he had received her letter he had already spoken to

Ralph Paull concerning the appointment. Mayor Blair also thanked Ruth Robinson for her interest in the open seat. Mayor Blair read the appointment requirements. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Dick Mecham 2<sup>nd</sup> to appoint Ralph Paull, till December 2016, to the seat left open by the resignation of Jo Hoppe. MCU. Ralph Paull accepted the appointment and then took the Oath of Office.** Melissa Walton stated to Council she will contact the Lake County Clerk's office and get certification coming.

**5.2 Tule Chiono- Lakeview Chamber of Commerce** Tule Chiono presented a pamphlet to the Council that highlights some of the many aspects of Paisley and its surrounding area. She asked that Council look it over and relay to her any changes or additions. Tule discussed her job with the Chamber and informed Council that she's working to insure that the mid and northern parts of the county are incorporated into all things "Lake County". She asked Council to inform her of any way the Chamber could be helpful to Paisley. Tule asked if the City of Paisley was interested in a membership with the Chamber. For \$100 a year the City would be listed on the website, included in multiple email blasts and included on the Chamber's Facebook page. One project the Chamber is currently involved in is a beautification project that she would like to see extended to Paisley, Summer Lake, Silver Lake and Christmas Valley. Tule also discussed the scenic byway and biking trails. Mayor Blair and Paisley City Council thanked Tule for coming and presenting them with this information.

**5.3 Vector Control** Melissa Walton informed Council that John Sanders has stated he is not interested in managing the Vector Control next year. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Dick Mecham 2<sup>nd</sup> to accept John Sanders resignation and to post the position, being sure to state the person selected needs a chemical license. MCU**

**6.1 Paisley Mosquito Festival Update** Melissa Walton presented a handout to Council showing the breakdown for this year's Festival. Since January 1, 2015 there has been \$11172.19 in revenue and \$7868.55 in expenses. There was a question brought up by a Community Member concerning the balance of the Mosquito Festival Fund. Melissa Walton reported she's spoken to Emma Villigrana and has done some "digging" through financials and she's getting different balances in different reports which she doesn't understand. She asked Council for permission to speak to a CPA to try to and resolve the issue. Council granted Melissa Walton permission. She will report findings next meeting.

**8.1 TSP Update**

Ronne Lindsay reported that the TSP had set up a website for online input but there had basically been no response. The TSP is in the process of reviewing its final draft. In the end, the City of Paisley will have a transportation plan. This is beneficial to the City as federal grants want TSP.
