Minutes of April 7, 2020
Regular Meeting

1.0 CALL TO ORDER/ PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on April 7, 2020 via teleconference and phone conference. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:35 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Kristine Funk, Robert Davis and Craig DeLarm. Others in attendance; Travis Way, Karon Paull, Toni Bailie, Joe Carlon, Lora Mayea and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0 EXECUTIVE SESSION

3.0 AGENDA & CONSENT CALENDAR

Craig DeLarm moved, Kristine Fund 2nd to approve the April 7, 2020 Agenda, the March 3, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes (with the correction that Dale Roberts was in attendance) and the March Invoices, MCU.

4.0 BUSINESS

4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent Travis reported everything is normal and going well.

4.2 Community Center Repair & Repainting Bids Melissa reported there was only one bid received for each RFQ. The repair bid from Kristopher Haggett is \$5,207.00. The repainting bid from CKO Painting Co. is for \$5,893.80. Craig asked if there was an amount for any excess cost. Kristine appreciated there was a completion date. Ralph stated Kris Haggett has a friend with a small mill that can cut pine boards; may match what was previously used. **Robert Davis moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to accept the repair bid from Kristopher A. Haggett, General Contractor for \$5,207.00 and the repainting bid from CKO Painting Company, Cheryl Kemry-Owens for \$5,893.80, MCU.**

4.3 Fletch & Strings Archery, SD3A - Lease Craig stated with the current situation, everything is on hold. There are some insurance issues he's struggling with. Ralph brought up the plan to lease the property for \$1.00, he wonders if by doing that the City wouldn't be setting a precedent for any other incoming business. Robert stated it's a matter of a business being for profit or a service. The contract is to be tabled for the moment.

4.4 Hunter Communications Hunter Communication is seeking permission to place fiber optic cable on the City's property adjacent to the Rodeo Grounds. **Craig DeLarm moved, Kristine Funk 2nd to grant Hunter Communications permission to place fiber optic cable on City property, map tax lot # 331E000000700, MCU.**

4.5 2020 Small City Allotment Grant, John Street Repair There was one bid received in response to the RFP. Joe Carlon from JR Carlon Corp was present to discuss his bid. He explained there is a little more footage than the last project but he still bid it at \$100,000.00. There will be a little more planning involved for traffic control as the street fronts the motel and ICFC. **Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd to accept the bid from JR Carlon Corp for \$100,000.00 for the repair of John Street from Stratton to Green, MCU.**

4.6 Vector Control One letter of interest received; from Bruce Gibbons. Bruce was involved with vector control back when the City first began the project. Although back then it was done by airplane. It's doubtful he still has credentials so he will need to get recertified. Council would like to visit with Bruce and will set up a special meeting on April 13th.

4.7 Bruce & Bonnie Wiegman, Building Permit Mr. & Mrs. Wiegman are wanting to place a work shed in their yard. They have presented a building permit application and a plat showing placement. **Dale Roberts moved, Kristine Funk 2nd to approve the building permit for Bruce & Bonnie Wiegman, MCU.**

4.8 Mayor's Review Campgrounds up river have been closed. There was signage with this information but they have been torn down so the Forest Service plans to replace them.

Budget is coming soon. If there are things needing budgeted for bring it to the City. Ralph feels a fund needs to be built for the Hazard Ordinance. If a pump goes out for drinking water, there needs to be a backup or at least funds to cover it. Money for vector control. Repairs and upkeep of the lagoon. Trees at the Community Center.

Ralph wonders about a free dump day. Would the County be willing and would people take advantage of it?

March 10 there was a phone conversation with Jim Bailey, the City Attorney, concerning Edward Horvath. The City cannot afford to sue Edward. On advice from Jim a letter voiding the contract has been sent to Edward. No comments.

5.0 REPORTS / CORRESPONDENCE There are three seats coming open this election year. If anyone is interested in filing for election the first day to file is June 3, 2020 and the last day is August 25, 2020. If anyone on Council hasn't completed their SEI filing, they have until April 15, 2020 and then they will begin to accrue fines.
