**Minutes of May 19, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on May 19, 2020 via teleconference at [www.freeconferencecall.com](http://www.freeconferencecall.com). Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:29 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Craig DeLarm, Robert Davis and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Karon Paull, Toni Bailie and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Dale Roberts moved, Krissy Funk 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve the May 19, 2020 Agenda and the May 5, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes with corrections, MCU.

- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is running fine.
- 4.2 Fletch & Strings Archery, SD3A - Lease** Working on the contract, table till next meeting.
- 4.3 SCA Road Grant, 2021 Application** The application will open June 1, 2020 through July 31, 2020. Council will discuss what project needs the most work at next meeting.
- 4.4 City Hall, Community Center & Bathrooms Opening or Not** After discussion Dale Roberts moved, Craig DeLarm 2<sup>nd</sup> to open City Hall, Community Center and the public restrooms effective today, MCU.
- 4.5 Vector Control Update** Melissa stated she’s received bills for the machine and chemical with a delivery date of May 21. Bruce has passed his test and will spray as soon as everything arrives.
- 4.6 Speed Limit Change** Ralph received an email from ODOT that stated after their study they are willing to lower the speed limit through town to 25 mph from 30 mph but they are not willing to move the speed zone. **Krissy Funk moved, Dale Roberts 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the speed limit change to 25 mph along Highway 31, MCU.**
- 4.7 Infrastructure Survey** SCOEDD sent out a survey asking for project needs if grant funds came available. Project discussed were the aerator for the lagoon, dredging the lagoon, repaying arsenic plant loan, replacing the entire fire hall

roof, replacing sewer and water lines and equipment needs. One survey will be filled out for each need.

**4.8 Hazard Ordinance Amendment** Melissa read the amendment for the Ordinance; there were no questions or comments. It will need to be read publicly one more time.

**4.9 Water/Sewer Ordinance #109** Ralph asked about an update on delinquent bills. Tabled till July.

**4.10 Dump Day** Melissa has been in contact with Buddy; there won't be a "Free Dump Day" but he and the County are working together to determine if there is a way to offset some of the cost. There was discussion on different ideas to handle garbage issues for community residents.

**4.11 Mayor's Review** Reminder of budget meeting on May 28<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 pm.

Ralph would like to show appreciation for the business people that have worked through the pandemic. Maybe a catered dinner.

The mosquito spraying poll conducted by Council members garnered both positive and negative comments. There were a lot of people that want the spray but some were upset about hiring someone and buying a machine before conducting the poll. They also worry about what is in the spray. It also brought some other issues. There is an alley blocked with cars and bikes. This was done because they believe there is a sinking culvert but some people who have looked don't think there is a problem. It also creates a hazard if a fire truck or medical personnel need to go down that lane. Council wants a letter sent concerning the blockage of the alley. There is a stop sign that needs replaced at Main and West. There was a complaint about dust from the fueling station, Ralph has contacted Miller Oil. Also up Mill St. from the fire line by Carlon's to the swimming hole there are bags full of used mens adult diapers.

The PVFD has ordered another truck at a cost of \$400 for delivery. It will be used to haul a pump around. They are looking into another vehicle for the City.
