

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of December 15, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on December 15, 2020. The meeting was held virtually via Zoom. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:42 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Craig DeLarm, and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Toni Bailie, Karon Paull and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Craig DeLarm moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to approve the December 15, 2020 Agenda, and the December 1, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes with the correction in section 4.5; “Trooper Tague” not “Deputy”, MCU.**
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is going well.
- 4.2 Swear in Toni Bailie** Toni Bailie took the oath of office and will fulfill the term for Dale Roberts; through December 2022.
- 4.3 Deer Ordinance** Council discussed how to get information to the community, who, what, where, when and why of the proposed ordinance. The process could take up to a year before it ever comes into effect. Council hopes to set up a meeting with Muir and Tague during the second half of January. **Toni Bailie moved, Krissy Funk 2<sup>nd</sup>, to include information on the January water/sewer bills, MCU.**
- 4.4 Mayor’s Review** Ralph has asked Missy to build and update a phone tree for our community members. He would like to have it on hand in case of an emergency such as the evacuation for the City this last fall. Having this will enable the Council to contact everyone efficiently. If used in conjunction with the County’s new alert system it will work be even better. Deputy Tague is willing to attend a meeting and make sure the system works correctly with the data we have.
- Ralph received an email with a funding opportunity for a biking community grant. He believes utilizing Kris and Michael Norris to write the grant would be perfect. **Toni Bailie moved, Craig DeLarm 2<sup>nd</sup>, to appoint Craig as the Council liaison to work with the Norris’ on developing a grant for the biking community, MCU.**
- Ralph would also like to talk to Anderson Engineering on another grant opportunity for repairing the water/sewer lines/system within the City.

**5.0 Reports / Correspondence** Krissy is still looking into FEMA money for upgrades to the water/sewer system.

Melissa had a discussion with the auditor concerning the fees for the community center. She was told the fees are not considered to be a donation if they **have** to be paid for usage as people are receiving something for the fee. It can be considered a donation if the City doesn't set a fee and just receives random donations for the center here and there. After discussion Council decided there should a fee to cover maintenance and cleaning. The discussion will be tabled till the next meeting. Members will gather number for similar venues in surrounding areas and work from there. Toni Bailie is going to contact Theresa Vickerman and talk to her about fees for the community center. Someone had been told when the building was first built, that it was agreed usage was to be free.
