**Notes of May 28, 2019**  
**Public Meeting**  
**with Three Rivers Mosquito & Vector Control**

The Public Meeting with Three Rivers Mosquito and Vector Control was held at the Paisley Community Center on May 28, 2019. The meeting began at 4:12 pm. Present were Mayor Ralph Paull, Councilman Craig DeLarm and Councilman Dale Roberts along with Recorder Melissa Walton. Three Rivers Owner Edward Horvath and Danta Smith.

Edward wants Council to approve the fee for spraying private property. But it was discussed that the City cannot agree to him spraying anyone's property, it's between him and the owners. He asks that all of Council be made aware of a \$5/per use fee or \$35/year fee. Asks to have the information included with the water/sewer bills.

Reviewed the menus and time frame for the three meals. Danta has been reviewing cooking rules and regulations and want to simplify the menu working to eliminate perishables. They are hoping to be able to use the tent from the Cowboy Poetry Group. They have a 10 foot long mosquito they are going to bring over just before the Festival. Want to add signage to add awareness to the Festival. The banner is going to be hung soon. Needs washed and the dates need changed. Edward suggests leaving the cables for the sides up for ease of access if the City would like to advertise other events. Missy will contact Joan about the Art Show, see if they are interested in a small showing.
