Public Meeting
with Three Rivers Mosquito & Vector Control

The Public Meeting with Three Rivers Mosquito and Vector Control was held at the Paisley Community Center on May 14, 2019. The meeting began at 4:04 pm. Present were Mayor Ralph Paull, Councilman Craig DeLarm and Councilwoman Krissy Funk along with Community Members Karon Paull, Joan Riha, Ila Jean Branum, Norma Jean Carlon, Lana Carlon, Alexa VanBelle, Clair VanBelle, Annie Larsen, Mikey Hernandez and Recorder Melissa Walton. Three Rivers Owner Edward Horvath and Danta Smith.

The menu and times for the Mosquito Festival Dinner and Lunch were discussed along with the Sunday breakfast. Edward and Danta welcomed all input and ideas. Everyone would like to see the Art Show continued but not sure if the Art Group is prepared for a showing this year. SVE will hang the new banner across the street. Edward proposed buying tshirts in mass and then having a highend iron on picture. Have some already made up but they can be made as they are ordered and paid for saving on overbuying which happens every year. The shirts are blanks so can be used the following year with a different iron on patch. He would like to get the school kids involved again in the picture design but not sure there is enough time left this school year to accomplish that. Will be doing the Jail n Bail again as it was a success last year. The Fun Run and 3 on 3 Basketball are schedule, along with the Parade. Considering a drone demonstration or flying course. Need volunteers for serving meals and for monitoring the bouncy houses. They are planning to sell bracelets for the bouncy house at \$15-\$19 for the weekend. Krissy suggested live music throughout the afternoon and is willing to look into setting that up. Hoping for more vendors, including a beer garden.

TRMVC plan to spray the last week of May. They will be larvaciding sooner dependent on weather. On the website there is a calendar link for spray dates and Mosquito Festival information. It was suggested that because there are a lot of community members wanting their private property sprayed, which the City is not responsible for, having the owners pay a fee for either every occurrence or for the season to Three Rivers. This money could then be incorporated into Mosquito Festival revenue. Edward wants Council to discuss this idea.
