

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of August 2, 2016**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on August 2, 2016 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Ralph Paull, Dick Mecham, Ronne Lindsay and Robert Davis Others in attendance; 2 members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

Melissa Walton reported that a community member suggested a town meeting to discuss the future of Mosquito Festival and vector control. **Ronne Lindsay moved, Ralph Paull 2<sup>nd</sup> to make it a part of the September meeting, MCU.**

**5.0 Old Business**

**5.1 Mosquito Festival Update** Mary Lou Sanchez stated to Council there had been a community member selling Festival t-shirts that he had had made himself. Tina Aguilar confirmed stating this person had not paid a vendor fee. During discussion Ronne Lindsay asked if the City had the rights to the “Mosquito Festival” logo but it was stated that no, it’s not trademarked. Tina stated that the original Festival shirts were a hassle. In paperwork she had submitted to the seller she wanted a mosquito in the heart on the front of shirt but it wasn’t. She didn’t realize till after the fact that the shirt didn’t have “Mosquito Festival” written on it anywhere. The sponsor shirts came in without the map on the backs of them. But the seller had fixed that issue; they sent the sponsor shirts back at their own expense and had the map placed on the back. Mrs. Aguilar would like to see the shirts become a “city shirt”. She stated the breakfast went well. The pigs were a mess and brought in no money. The dance was free but she believes it went well. There was one vendor that was unhappy with their location so they packed up and went to the rodeo grounds. When the rodeo club tried to collect their vendor fee the people stated no, they had already paid. Tina has been told that fee will be deducted from the money

coming to the City. Council states there's to be an itemized breakdown showing where money came from. This issue will be addressed when that is received from the rodeo club. Council gave Tina permission to try and sell some of the t-shirts on e-bay.

**6.0 New Business**

**6.1 OLCC Renewals** Melissa presented to Council the list of businesses needing to renew their licenses. Council asked about The Homestead being listed under Dave and Rose Hall. Melissa stated she hasn't received any notice from Rose asking for a name change. **Ronne Lindsay moved, Ralph Paull 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the OLCC renewals for Pioneer Saloon and Paisley Mercantile, along with The Homestead after the name has been amended. MCU.**

**6.2 Vector Control** Melissa reported to Council Lee Pangburn had passed all tests and is waiting on a license from the state. Mary Lou Sanchez asked if there shouldn't be a back-up person for the position. Mayor Blair reported the City had paid for numerous tests and asked if Council shouldn't stipulate a limit on how many tests they are willing to pay for. The matter is to be tabled till September.

The list she had said three but in talking with the County Clerk, there are only two; Ralph Paull's and Robert Davis's. She reminded them they have until August 30 to file papers with the County Clerk.
