## *2024 City Council Election-Important Dates*

At the 2024 General Election on November 5<sup>th</sup>, three positions for Paisley City Councilors will appear on the ballot.

- All positions are non-partisan.
- All positions, other than Mayor, are volunteer, and non-paid.
- All terms will begin January 6, 2025, at the first meeting of the City Council.
- The two seats that acquire the highest votes will serve a four-year term while the seat with the least amount of votes will serve a two-year term.
- During the January 6, 2025, meeting, the Council will vote for Mayor. The Mayor will hold that position for two years.

Below are the Councilors whose terms expire on December 31, 2024.

### *Method of Filing*

A person must file the SE 101 Candidate Filing – Major Political Party or Nonpartisan form. **The first day to file for the November 5, 2024, General Election is June 5, 2025, and the last day to file for the November 5, 2024, General Election is August 27, 2024, at 5:00 pm. The form needs to be filed with the Lake County Clerks Office at 513 Center Street in Lakeview.** This form is available at Paisley City Hall, 705 Chewaucan Street, or at the County Clerks Office in Lakeview.

### *Qualifications and Residency Requirements*

To qualify as a candidate for City Councilor, you must be:

- A qualified elector under the laws and Constitution of the State of Oregon.
- A registered voter of the City of Paisley, and
- A resident of the City of Paisley, who has resided continuously within city limits during the 12 months immediately preceding the election.
