

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of March 16, 2021**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on March 16, 2021 at the Paisley Community Center. People were also welcome to join via Zoom. President Craig DeLarm called the meeting to order at 1:50 pm. after the Council was given a demonstration of the Paisley Disaster Unit’s new lifts for the ambulances. Council Members in attendance were Craig DeLarm, Ruth Robinson, Toni Bailie and Krissy Funk (via Zoom). Others in attendance: Travis Way and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve the March 16, 2021 Agenda and the March 2, 2021 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.**

- 3.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis stated everything is running fine. He will have some discussion items for the next meeting concerning the water/sewer ordinance.
- 3.2 Mosquito Festival 2021** Melissa stated to Council she had received a couple calls in the last few days asking if there was going to be a Mosquito Festival this year. Council asked her to check with Amy Davis and Patty Westgate to see what the Mosquito Festival Committee intended to do. They stated it should be fine to hold the festival as long as all state mandates are upheld and met. Suggests having most everything outdoors. Melissa did contact Amy Davis and she stated that the committee plans to hold events throughout the year for fundraising but she was not sure they would be able to hold the festival as she is not able to head the committee this summer.
- 3.3 Brownfields Public Meeting** Melissa stated there will be a final public meeting for the second phase of the Brownfields Grant. This meeting will be at noon on April 8<sup>th</sup>, lunch will be served. They are still waiting to hear back on whether or not they were successful in their application for the grant for the third phase.
- 3.4 Budget Resolution** Resolution #2021-01 031621; resolution to move \$25,000.00 from the operating contingency within the Water and Sewer Maintenance Fund into the Materials and Services within the Water and Sewer Maintenance Fund for the purpose of paying for a Water Master Plan. The City has been awarded a forgivable loan for this project and all costs up to \$25,000.00 are reimbursed through this grant. **Toni Bailie moved, Ruth Robinson 2<sup>nd</sup>, to approve the resolution to transfer the money, MCU.**
- 3.5 Mayor’s Review** On behalf of Ralph Paull, Craig discussed some upcoming House Bills that people should be paying attention to.

Reminded everyone of the LOC Townhall meetings that have taken place and the Zoom meetings they are holding on Fridays. They have discussed many different grant opportunities for rural communities.

Council discussed different problems people have been experiencing in Paisley lately, such as theft, trespassing and delinquency. They want to advise the community to secure and lock up personal property. If and when they are approached by the individuals causing concern, everyone is strongly encouraged to not engage and to call 911. Cleanup costs and methods were also discussed along with property liens.
