Special Work Session

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance The Special Work Session of the City of Paisley was held on July 6, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig Delarm called the meeting to order at 11:10 am. Council Members in attendance were Craig Delarm, Toni Bailie and Ruth Robinson. Travis Way (tried to call in) and Krissy Funk absent. Others in attendance: Amy Davis, Danni Cardoza and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the July 6, 2021 Agenda, MCU.

3.0 Business

3.1 Mosquito Festival Update Amy Davis gave Council a copy of the donation list the committee has put together for the bbq. They are hoping to get some items donated to help offset costs. They plan to hang it at the post office and then put posters around town letting people know they can go there to sign up. All donations need to be in by July 15 so they know what they need to purchase. Duane Young is going to need some help cleaning up the pit before the bbq. They've ordered the meat through Howards in Klamath Falls.

Emmett Williams designed the logo for the shirts. They purchased blank shirts and will be press them as needed, hoping to eliminate waste and excess.

They found a bounce house and a water slide for about \$1100 total. Insurance cost is \$1000 a year for liability. The committee feels they can raise that money through donations and sponsorships. They plan to have the parents sign a waiver and to charge \$5 per day for an all-day bracelet.

They have \$1000 donation coming from Pacific Crest FCU plus 400 plates; they want a banner hung during the festival. They have been promised another \$550 so far with others getting back to them soon. The fundraisers they've planned so far: Thanksgiving, Winter Carnival, Halloween, Valentines, St. Patty's, Mother Day Brunch, Donuts with Dad. They are working on annual sponsorships. PCFCU is also willing to have people come to volunteer during the festival.

They have a couple of vendors for this year. They are only charging \$20 for the weekend because the festival is so small this year and they are trying to get it up and going again.

There will be an information booth in the yard.

The parade will be Saturday morning.

All meals will be based out of the Community Center this year. There will be the bbq Saturday and then the Church is doing a pancake breakfast Sunday morning.

They would like to hold a community dance Friday night from 8 to 11. There will be no alcohol, no exceptions. There will be people watching and making sure it remains alcohol free.

Toni Bailie moved, Ruth Robinsons 2nd, to approve the insurance premium and purchasing the water slides, MCU.

Amy is also going to be contacting the sheriff's office asking to have a presence during the entire weekend.
