Regular Meeting

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Public Hearing and Special Meeting meeting of the City of Paisley was held on June 29, 2021 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Craig Delarm called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm. Council Members in attendance were Craig Delarm, Toni Bailie and Ruth Robinson. Travis Way and Krissy Funk absent. Others in attendance: Serena Abell, Lora Mayea, Nikki Vickerman and Brett Vickerman and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** Already approved.
- 3.0 Business**
- 3.1 Public Hearing for Conditional Use Permit for Nicole Vickerman** Melissa stated she had sent out the letters to neighboring properties but had not received anything back nor had anyone come to the meeting to object. **Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve the conditional use permit for Nicole Vickerman. MCU.**
- 3.2 Enact Resolutions to Receive State Revenue Sharing, Adopt the Budget, Make Appropriations, Impose & Categorize Taxes for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year.** Before approval Melissa suggested moving \$4000 within the Street Fund from the unappropriated ending fund balance into Capital Outlay to begin purchasing speed signs for the City, an endeavor that has been frequently discussed but the City has not been able to move forward as the money is unavailable to buy all they need. Start small and work up. **Ruth Robinson moved, Toni Bailie 2nd, to approve moving \$4000 into Capital Outlay in the Street Fund. To enact Resolution No. 2021-02 062921 to adopt the budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 in the total amount of \$559,397.00 and to pass an Ordinance Declaring the City’s Election to Receive State Revenues for fiscal year 2021-2022. To make Appropriations for all funds in the amount of \$429,421.00 and total of reserve and unappropriated amounts, \$129,976.00 for a total adopted budget of \$559397.00. To impose the ad valorem property taxes of all taxable property within the district for tax year 201-2022 at the rate of \$1.5739 per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for permanent rate tax. That the taxes imposed are hereby categorized for purposes of Article XI section 11b as: Subject to the General Government Limitation - \$1.5739 / \$1000.00, MCU.**
- 3.3 Mosquito Festival Update** Melissa spoke with Amy Davis, head of the Festival Committee. They would like to purchase a bouncy house and water slide for entertainment for the kids. Melissa has put a call into the insurance carrier. They are buying shirts and have access to a press to make them as needed. It was suggested contacting Terry Carlon also, she has a commercial press. **Toni Bailie**

moved, Ruth Robinson 2nd, to approve buying the water slide and bounce house contingent upon insurance, MCU.
