

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of January 3, 2017**  
**Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on January 3, 2017 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Ralph Paull, Dick Mecham and Robert Davis. Others in attendance; Dale Roberts and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

**2.0 Swear in Newly Elected Council Members**

**2.1 Elect Mayor and President of Council** Outgoing Mayor Dale Blair turned the meeting over to Melissa Walton, acting as Deputy. Melissa asked the new Council Members, Robert Davis, Ralph Paull and Dale Roberts to stand, raise their right hands and read their Oath of Office. Each member then signed their official Oath of Office certificate. Next nominations were opened for mayor. **Ralph moved, Robert 2<sup>nd</sup> to nominate Dale Blair as Mayor of the City of Paisley, MCU. Nomination closed, vote unanimously passed in favor.** Next nominations were opened for President of Council. **Robert moved, Dick 2<sup>nd</sup> to nominate Ralph Paull as President of Council, MCU. Nominations closed, vote unanimously passed in favor.** Meeting then turned back over to Mayor Blair.

**3.0 Agenda Approval**

Melissa stated in regards to 6.1, 7.1 and 7.2 these people were unable to attend meeting because of weather but 7.1, Darwin Johnson had sent an email, which is included in Council packets. **Robert moved, Dick 2<sup>nd</sup> to accept the Agenda as amended. Melissa reported this was for a SOC test that has to be done every 3 years for nitrates, synthetic organic chemicals and volatile organic chemicals. It's a very large test with a lot of samples. **Robert moved, Ralph 2<sup>nd</sup> to accept the minutes as written and the December invoices, MCU.**

Russ gave her a name and phone number of a gentleman that has a team that will come out and help to resolve issues. Melissa will contact him and see if there is a fee for these services.

Dale R. asked what had become of the nuisance ordinance. It was explained that if Council adopts an ordinance that they know they can't enforce, be it financial reason or not having an enforcement agent, then the City is then held liable for the nuisance issue. Something the City cannot afford at this time.

Dale R. also asked about an Ordinance Book. Years ago Rosie Bagley had made a book with all the City Ordinances in it. He would like to find one. Melissa stated if he did she would be able to copy and distribute to Council.
