Minutes of July 3, 2018
Regular Meeting

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on July 3, 2018 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Ruth Robinson, Dale Roberts, Kim Way and Robert Davis. Others in attendance 3 members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar With a correction of the date on the Agenda, Ruth Robinson moved and Kimberly Way 2nd to approve the June 5, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes, the June 5' 2018 Budget Hearing Minutes and the June Invoices, MCU.

4.0 Business

4.1 Cemetery Water Councilwoman Kim Way asked how much water the new system for the cemetery would use and how much of an impact there would be on the pumps of the existing water system? When the City had been approached last year concerning the new system it had been figured they would use approximately 10,000 gallons a day. They City had reviewed and discussed it and agreed to the new metered system.

4.2 Mosquito Festival Update Councilwoman Ruth Robinson reports she was the only community member that showed up for the meeting with Edward. They need someone for the 3 on 3 basketball tournament and are wondering if courts will be repaved by then. There will be a duck race, face painting, wondering if Pierre Hoppe would be interested in announcing the parade entries. The 4th of July festivities have been moved from the school to Jolie Murphy's house. Someone had made contact with the Fire Department to make sure it was ok to use legal fireworks. They will have a truck on standby.

4.3 Community Center Repairs Melissa reports still waiting on call back and looking into other places for repair on the floor. The new heating/cooling system has been installed by Seasons Change and is working beautifully.

4.4 Marie Leehmann, Hancock/Flick Memorial Mrs. Leehman reports via phone conversation, they are setting up to run the dance in front of the Community Center, the show towards the Post Office and the bar will be in between. Dinner to be served inside. Everything will be shut down by

10:30 pm. Dinner will run 4:00 to 6:00. The auction will follow the poetry show.

4.5 Past Due Bills Melissa reports a person has come forward willing to assist a family with a past due bill. The donor has asked if they pay ½ the bill can the other ½ be forgiven. After discussion Council agrees that there needs to be a signed contract/agreement between the two parties stipulating payments and consequences of nonpayment on either side before Council is willing to concede anything.

4.6 Less Than 28 Day Rental Councilman Dale Roberts reports he has researched some of the issues and concerns with the Air BnBs and other short term rentals. From information he's gathered it is lawful in Oregon to have an Air B&B on residential property but the owner is also responsible for paying room tax in that city/county. It was suggested to talk to the County also.

5.0 Reports / Correspondence

5.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent Travis reported there was a water leak up Mill St. which has been repaired. Cones have been placed over the repair allowing it to set up good, hoping to keep it from breaking again.

June tests all came back good. Arsenic test came in at 0.005.

The City pickups are not in good condition. The one Travis drives has a transmission problem. The old blue and white one is not in very good condition either. Asks if Council can look into the government surplus and see if there is anything the City can purchase at a reasonable price.

Melissa reminded everyone there are three positions coming up for election. If anyone wants to run the deadline to file is August 28.
