

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of January 2, 2018**  
**Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on January 2, 2018 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Dale Roberts, Ruth Robinson, Kim Way and Robert Davis. Others in attendance 3 members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

**2.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar Ruth Robinson moved, Dale Roberts 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the January 2, 2018 Agenda with the addition of 4.6, “Paving”, approve the December 5, 2017 Regular Meeting Minutes with the corrections (6.2 – change Brad Kresge to Len Culp) and approve the December invoices. MCU.**

**3.0 Public Input**

Florence Jayne with her sister, Joan Riha, addressed concerns about the cougar that’s been seen in town several time. Mrs. Jayne states she along with several towns people would like to see it gone.

Mary Lou Sanchez asks that Council consider selling her the property located behind St. John’s Catholic Church. She doesn’t plan to build at this time but would like to purchase the ground or be put on a list for future consideration.

**4.0 Business**

**4.1 Nuisance Ordinance** Ralph Paull asked Council if they had been able to review the proposed ordinance and if they had any suggested changes. Knowing that Paisley doesn’t have the funding to enforce any violation of the proposed ordinance, Mr. Paull has suggested approaching the County to see if they would be willing to work in conjunction with the City. One idea being that instead of the City placing a lien on property when a landowners fails to comply, having the County take the City’s roll and place the lien ensuring the County would benefit from the partnership. **Robert Davis moved, Kimberly Way 2<sup>nd</sup> to approach Lake County Commissioners concerning helping the City with enforcement of a Nuisance Ordinance. MCU.** Ruth Robinson stated she hopes to see someone from Paisley or Christmas Valley run for Commissioner Dan Shoun’s seat, which he plans to vacate in 2019. Council agrees.

**4.2 Resolution #2018-01 and #2018-02, Accepting Grant Funds from The Ford Family Foundation and Oregon Parks and Recreation for Repairing the Basketball Court Ruth Robinson moved, Kimberly Way 2<sup>nd</sup> to adopt Resolution #2018-01 and #2018-02 to accept grant funds from The Ford Family Foundation in the amount of \$5,600.00**

and Oregon Parks and Recreation, in the amount of \$30,500.00, \$6,100.00 to be a match from the City. Both grants are to be used for the repairs of the basketball court. MCU.

- 4.3 **Building Permit, Dean & Shelley Nasby** Kimberly Way moved, Ruth Robinson 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the building permit for the driveway at 502 Mill St., replacing the sidewalk out to the roadway. MCU.
- 4.4 **Signage West of Community Center** Robert Davis moved, Dale Roberts 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion due to safety concerns, to approach ODOT requesting some type of “No Parking” signage be installed on west side of Community Center. MCU.
- 4.5 **Heating System for the Community Center** Ralph Paull spoke with Len Culp of Surprise Valley Electrification concerning buying and installing a new heating system for the Community Center. Mr. Culp has told Mr. Paull that Bonneville Energy Trust will put \$2,000.00 towards the Project. Earlier this morning Mr. Paull and Dale Roberts spoke to the Lake County Commissioners during their work session requesting more money to help cover the cost. Council discussed the pros and cons of getting the smaller unit for \$7,000.00 or the larger one for \$11,000. All agreed the larger unit may be best as it wouldn't have to work so hard to effectively do the job required. **Robert Davis moved, Ruth Robinson 2<sup>nd</sup> approving the motion to approach the Forest Service requesting more funds to purchase the bigger unit.**
- 4.6 **Mosquito Festival** Council needs to spread the word and see if anyone is interested in heading this event.
- 4.7 **Repairs to City Building (Food Share/Fire Hall)** The roof has been repaired over the leak but is showing a need for more work. Adam Albertson will need to submit a supplemental bid to CIS for the excess.
- 4.8 **Work Session with Duane Young on Mapping and Information** Council agrees to Work Session on Thursday, January 4<sup>th</sup> @ 4:00 pm.
- 4.9 **Paving** Ralph Paull spoke to Bobbie Carlon concerning a more detailed bid. Hoping to have everything set up and ready to go as soon as weather permits.

  - 6.1 **Mountain Lion** Discussed in Public Appearances
  - 6.2 **Arsenic** Melissa Walton reported to Council the Arsenic sample came in at 0.00965 mg/L, still under the standard but getting close to the limit. Ralph Paull is going to address the Superintendent with the concerns.
