Minutes of October 20, 2020
Regular Meeting

- 1.0 **Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on October 20, 2020 at Paisley City Hall. President Dale Roberts called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Roberts, Craig DeLarm and Krissy Funk. Others in attendance: Tony Cardoza, Deanne Yoder, Amy Davis and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 **Executive Session** None
- 3.0 **Agenda & Consent Calendar** Krissy Funk moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd, to approve the October 20, 2020 Agenda and the October 6, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.
- 4.0 **Business**
- 4.1 **Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis was unable to attend, nothing to report.
- 4.2 **Insurance for Home Owners on Water/Sewer Piping** Jim Bailey, the City Attorney has said he sees no issues with accepting the royalty payments for the City on the personal insurance for homeowners. **Krissy Funk moved, Craig DeLarm 2nd, the approve promoting the homeowner insurance policy for water and sewer piping, MCU.**
- 4.3 **Fundraiser** Amy Davis stated she believes the fundraiser should be held after the first of the year, maybe around March. She talked about the festivities planned for Halloween; the committee is working to follow COVID regulations. Melissa presented a few different forms for the fundraising efforts; donation forms, ordering forms, logs. Next month Council will work on dates.
- 4.4 **Policies and Procedures** Council agrees there needs to be guidelines as to procedure when an extension is requested with the hazard ordinance. October 22nd is the deadline for the extension on one property being currently worked on. Council members that are available will meet on Thursday at 3:00 pm to take pictures and note progress on this property.
- 5.0 **Reports / Correspondence** Melissa reported she has a check for JR Carlon Corp for the road work completed on John Street. Normally Ralph would sign the check also because of the high amount, but he is out of town for a bit and she needs to get it sent out. Just wanted to make sure Council is aware of what she's doing.
- 6.0 **Public Appearances** Deanna Yoder asked about the deer surplus in town and asked if the City planned to do anything about them. It was explained that an ordinance needs to be

passed stating no one can feed the deer, including letting fruit/vegetation lie on the ground (giving access) and that in order to harvest the deer and give them to Food Share there has to be inspections and a certified butcher, all requiring funding.

Tony Cardoza stated he's seen a wolf close to his property. Craig is going to set up a camera to gather information then it will be passed off to ODFW.
