

**City of Paisley  
Minutes of August 5, 2014  
Regular Meeting**

**1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance**

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on August 5, 2014 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Mark Douglas called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Mark Douglas, Dale Blair, Jo Hoppe and Ronne Lindsay. Others in attendance; Duane Young, Water / Wastewater Superintendent, Mary Lou Sanchez, Carol Karlson and Emma Villagrana, City Recorder.

**2.0 Agenda Approval**

**Dale Blair moved and Ronne Lindsay 2nd to approve the Agenda with Ronne's addition of Food Share Toilet added as 6.3 New Business MCU**

**3.0 Consent Calendar**

**3.1/3.2 Minutes for July1, 2014 Regular Meeting, July 21, 2014 Special Meeting and July Invoices. Dale Blair moved and Jo Hoppe 2nd to approve the Consent Calendar. MCU**

**4.0 Public Input**

Mary Lou Sanchez requested that the Information Booth be supported better when it is set up next year. Jo Hoppe stated that it is on the list for Mosquito Festival Planning for next year.

Carol Karlson requested permission to reside in her 5<sup>th</sup> wheel temporarily. Mayor Douglas stated that she needed to be put on the agenda for the City to take any action on the matter. The Recorder will put her on the agenda for September's regular meeting and send a copy of City Ordinance to her as to be informed of the City's regulations pertaining to this issue.

**5.0 Old Business**

**5.1 Arsenic Treatment Update. Mayor Douglas informed the Council that 5 contractors came to the mandatory pre-bid meeting held on July 29, 2014. Bid Opening will be held on August 12, 2014.**

**5.2 Paisley Mosquito Festival Update. Jo Hoppe presented the Council with a report detailing the financials of the festival. This year the festival did very well and has heard a lot of positive remarks about all of the events. Duane Young asked that if the kids water slide was here next year that it be set up differently so as not to damage the grass.**

- 5.3 **Paisley Disaster Unit – Lease – Action**  
After discussion and review of the proposed Lease agreement between the City of Paisley and the Paisley Disaster Unit, several changes were recommended. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Dale Blair 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Lease agreement as amended contingent upon the City Attorney’s approval. MCU**

**6.0 New Business**

- 6.1 **OLCC Liquor License Renewals**  
After Review of the list from the State OLCC, Council directed Emma Villagrana to notify the businesses listed that the City had raised its Liquor License fee to \$5.00 rather than the \$2.50 reported by the State. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Dale Blair 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the Liquor Licenses of the businesses listed for renewal by the State of Oregon contingent upon payment of City’s fee.**

- 6.2 **Hand Dryer Purchase**  
Council heard comment about purchasing hand dryers for the public restrooms. One Dryer costs that same as one case of Paper Towels, that is combined with the fact that they should help the cleanliness of the bathrooms. **Ronne Lindsay moved and Jo Hoppe 2<sup>nd</sup> to purchase two Hand Dryers and pay for installation. MCU**

- 6.3 **Food Share Toilet** Ronne Lindsay requested that the Food Share be allowed to remove the toilet because of a reported unfortunate incident that occurred earlier this month. She requested that the room be used instead for additional needed storage. This item will be put on next month’s agenda for action.
