

**City of Paisley**  
**Minutes of December 1, 2020**  
**Regular Meeting**

- 1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance** The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on December 1, 2020. The meeting was held virtually via FreeConferenceCall. Mayor Ralph Paull called the meeting to order at 2:40 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Ralph Paull, Craig DeLarm, Krissy Funk and Robert Davis. Others in attendance: Travis Way, Toni Bailie, Karon Paull and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.
- 2.0 Executive Session** None
- 3.0 Agenda & Consent Calendar** **Craig DeLarm moved, Krissy Funk 2nd, to approve the December 1, 2020 Agenda, and the November 17, 2020 Regular Meeting Minutes, MCU.**
- 4.0 Business**
- 4.1 Travis Way, Water Superintendent** Travis checked the meter at 661 Mill Street. The padlock had been removed and water was being used. Travis reinstalled a lock. Melissa is going to call the sheriff's office again.
- Travis also informed Council he's been told they are closing Warner Prison down sometime between 2021 and 2023. This will have a large impact on Lake County.
- 4.2 Vacant Council Seat** Melissa received two letters of interest for Dale Robert's open council seat; one from Toni Bailie and one from Robert Davis. Ralph called for a vote from current Councilors. **Krissy Funk voted for Robert Davis. Craig DeLarm voted for Toni Bailie. Robert Davis abstained. To break the tie, Ralph Paull voted for Toni Baile.** Toni will be sworn in in January.
- 4.3 Paisley Disaster Unit, Grant** Update – Melissa has submitted the request for \$23,000 for the Disaster Unit and \$2,000 for the City. The money for PDU is to buy and install a power lift in the ambulance. The money for the City is to cover costs for disinfection and public safety equipment for the Community Center and public restrooms.
- 4.4 Amy Davis, Winter Carnival** No update.
- 4.5 Deer Ordinance** Ralph is working on the proposal for ODFW concerning harvesting of town deer. Council wants to poll the community on the idea, work on educating the community as to the whys and hows, and also meet with Trooper Tague and Mr. Muir and Becky Hyde with ODFW to discuss the proposal and means.

**4.6 Supplemental Budget** Tabled till second meeting in January.

**4.7 Mayor's Review** Ralph wants the Home Serve information is included on the water bill making sure it's understood this is private insurance for privately owned property not for City property. Craig is going to write a synopsis on "For Sale in Paisley".

He talked to Dr. Ferry with the vet's office concerning the town deer. He asked if there was a means to take samples to ensure there are no pathogens. Dr. Ferry stated he believes the deer are healthy and suggested not harvesting when there are a lot of pesticides or insecticides being used.

In January the newly elected Council members will be sworn in and they will vote for Mayor and President.
