

City of Paisley
Minutes of May 2, 2017
Regular Meeting

1.0 Call To Order/ Pledge of Allegiance

The Regular Council meeting of the City of Paisley was held on May 2, 2017 at Paisley City Hall. Mayor Dale Blair called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. Council Members in attendance were Dale Blair, Ralph Paull, Robert Davis and Dale Roberts. Others in attendance; 11 members of the public and Melissa Walton, City Recorder.

2.0&3.0 Agenda Approval & Consent Calendar

Dale Roberts moved, Robert Davis 2nd to approve the April 4, 2017 Meeting Minutes, the April 17, 2017 and Special Meeting Minutes MCU.

4.0 Public Input

Pierre and Jo Hoppe donated a 1992 Ford Pickup to the City. Council is undecided as to where to put the truck to use at this time. **Robert Davis moved, Ralph Paull 2nd to accept with gratitude the donation of the truck from the Hoppe's, MCU.**

The City is also receiving a 1977 C-65 Fire Truck donated by Oregon Outback R.F.P.D. along with various fire fighting equipment.

Community members inquired about the arsenic situation. Mayor Blair stated the last results were 0.016 mgL, still up from 0.01 mgL which is the limit. He also stated the City has been working with two circuit riders from OAWU. Other circuit riders with OHA have called and offered their services. Michael Cuff, a safety manager with the Forest Service, was also on hand and offered his service and experience to the City. It was also asked if the City has a plan for the future, say if the next two samples came back noncompliant for arsenic. Mayor Blair replied that the City is still striving to fix the issues at the plant. Not only does the City want the problem resolved but in connection with the Administrative Order from OHA they have to get the issue resolved within a set time limit. There isn't enough time or funding to go in a different direction. It was suggested looking into USDA grants to overhaul the system tanks, pumps and piping.

Two community members came forward asking about the Nuisance Officer hired by Lake County. The newspaper states the Officer cannot enforce within the town of Lakeview or the City of Paisley. Council confirmed this but states they were told that with a new resolution there may be a means to use the Officer within the City limits. This is something the Council will be researching and discussing at a future date.

Community members expressed concern at how they could be notified when there is an issue. Mailing is one means but that takes time. There is a local radio station but how do you make sure everyone is listening. Council is going to research the issue.

5.0 Old Business

5.1 Amendment of Ordinance 109, adding wording Dale Blair read Section 13, subsection 1, of Ordinance 109 noting the changes of adding “/she” to his throughout and adding “and/or sewer” on lines 1 and 4 within water services. **Ralph Paull moved, Dale Roberts 2nd to approve wording of Ordinance 109 Section 13, subsection 1, MCU.**

5.2 Mosquito Festival Update Patty Westgate has received the shirts. Has a quote on caps but would like to redo the design for them before Council approves.

5.3 Damage to City Building, Repairs Only received one bid. Council tabled discussion until next meeting.

5.4 Community Center, heater/cooler Ralph Paull spoke to Tracy with Seasons Change, LLC out of Klamath concerning a swirl venting system that sounds to be more efficient for the Community Center. They are guessing \$4000-\$5000 for a new system. Ralph asked Patty if VIPs would be interested in helping with a spaghetti fundraiser to begin a fund. May look into grants also.

5.5 Grant Update

- 1. Basketball Court** Dale Roberts reports he is waiting on answer to his requests. One grant hinges on another.
- 2. City Streets** Melissa reports she has a call into Bob Carlon on bid for repairs to West and Willow St. Has spoke to Scott Mobley from Dog Lake Construction, he is sending something soon. It was recommending speaking to Gary McCleese also.
- 3. Speed Zone** Ralph Paull stated he received an email from ODOT concerning the speed zone request. They have forwarded it to Dan Scerpio within Region 4 to look further into the request.

6.0 New Business

6.1 Abby Sanders, Community Project Melissa states that Abby has requested permission to make a planter and plant flowers or some type of beautification where the tree fell at the Post Office recently. **Ralph Paull moved, Robert Davis 2nd to grant Abby Sanders permission for the beautification project at the Post Office contingent on the land being City property, MCU.**

6.2 Joe Carlson, Administrative Order Mayor Blair read aloud the Administrative Order. Council needs to make an action plan with the help of

Mike Norris and Duane Young. Logs have to be kept daily. Set up a work session.

6.3 Lawn Contract Robert Davis moved, Ralph Paull 2nd to award the lawn contract to Robert Fritz, MCU.

6.4 Vector Control, Vehicle Council undecided as to giving the donated truck for Vector Control. No one wants to create hardship between the Community and Council but worries that the current City truck is in poor condition. Mayor Blair is going to revisit having the Vector Control truck cleaned and installing new seat covers. Working on having Community Service clean the building.

6.5 Paisley Disaster Unit, Doug Young, Building Permit Doug Young presented plans to build an addition to the existing building adding storage and a bathroom. The Disaster Unit plans to vacate the old storage building after storage is built but asks permission to be able to use if they ever purchase another ambulance. The Unit is asking for a lower monthly rate as they rarely use the building. Council is tabling the issue for the moment. **Ralph Paull moved, Dale Roberts 2nd to approve the permit to build the addition on the new ambulance barn for a bathroom and storage area, MCU.**

6.6 Propane Tank at City Equipment Building Melissa stated she had to call Ed Staubs for a propane leak at the City Equipment Building. During their inspection of the tank they found the valves are very old and broken and would cost to replace. Also there are repairs needing done to the lines within the Equipment Building and the Fire Station. After discussion **Ralph Paull moved, Robert Davis 2nd to replace the old tank with a rental from Ed Staubs for \$68/year and to get the repairs done within the two buildings that Ed Staub recommended, MCU.**
